For the first citation, one needs a \citet* to lay out a full author list, as Rajan, Salgaonkar, and Joshi [2020] demonstrate, and this is not different for citing documents that have less than three authors as in Desai [2015]. One need not worry about citing several documents together, as in Sardesai [2006], Charniak and McDermott [1985] or [Wijeratne and de Silva, 2021, Upeksha et al., 2015] or Sampson et al., 2009, Sampson, 1995,2002. One can also choose to cite Wirth[1996-2005] with the year given differently.
